Our Story

King William Charles Lunalilo, the 6th king of Hawai'i, established a Trust Fund to benefit the less fortunate of Native Hawaiian ancestry, with a preference to kūpuna. Following his death, Lunalilo Home was established in 1883 in the Makiki area. In 1927, the Home was relocated to its current site on the slopes of Koko Head Crater in Hawaii Kai.
