Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalaniana'ole

Prince Kuhio Day is a state holiday observed in Hawai'i on March 26. The day honors the life of Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalaniana'ole and his many accomplishments in service of his people and the Hawaiian Islands.

He served as a non-voting delegate from Hawai'i to the House of Representatives in Congress from 1902 until his death in 1922.

He helped pass the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act as well as form the first Hawaiian Civic Club, a movement that now boats over 50 organizations across Hawai'i and the continent.


